And bony hands and feet.

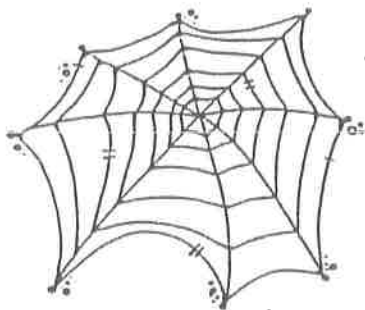
Bony, bony, bony bones
