

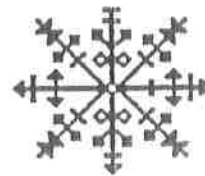
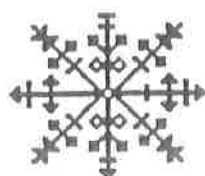
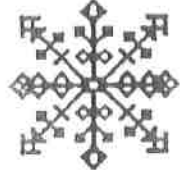
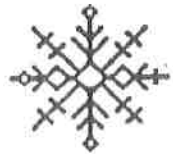
SLEDDING SONG

The Sun and the Moon

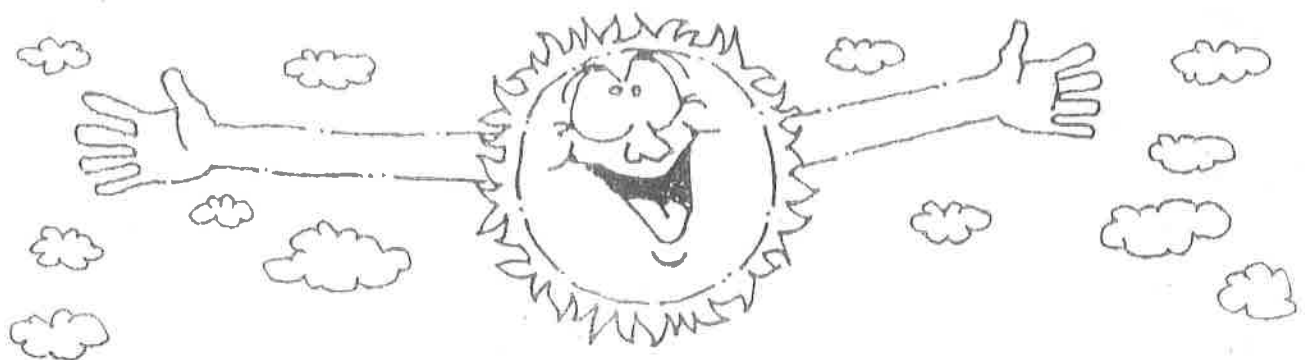
The Sun is filled with shining light

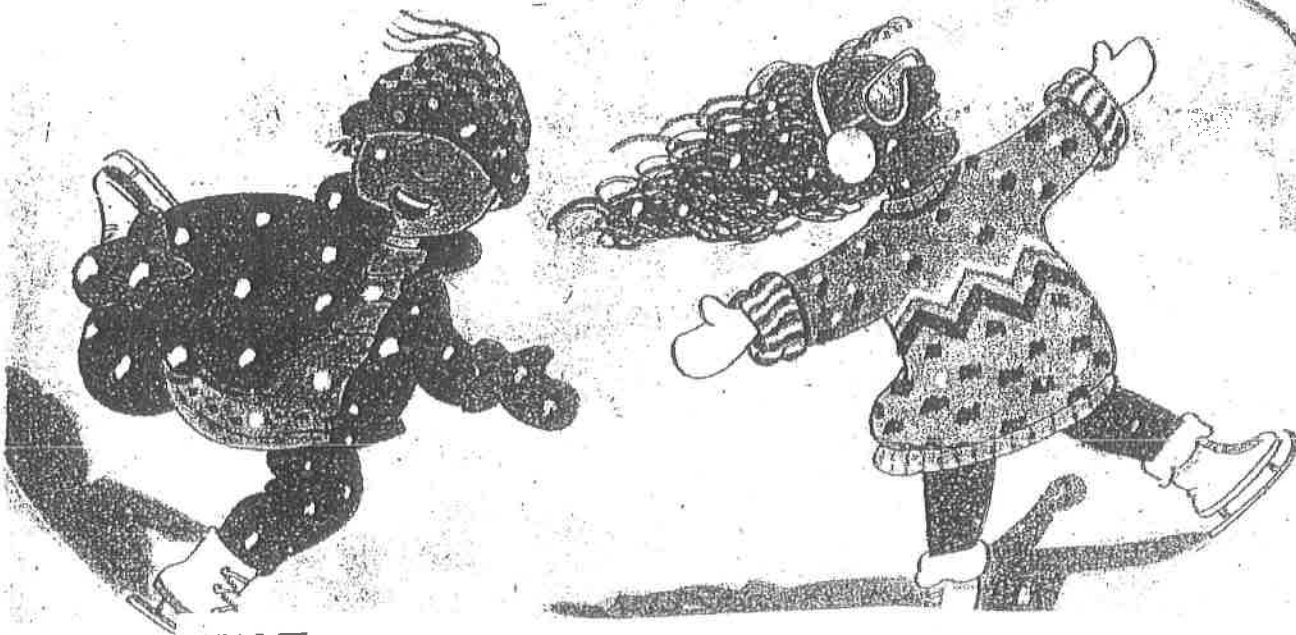

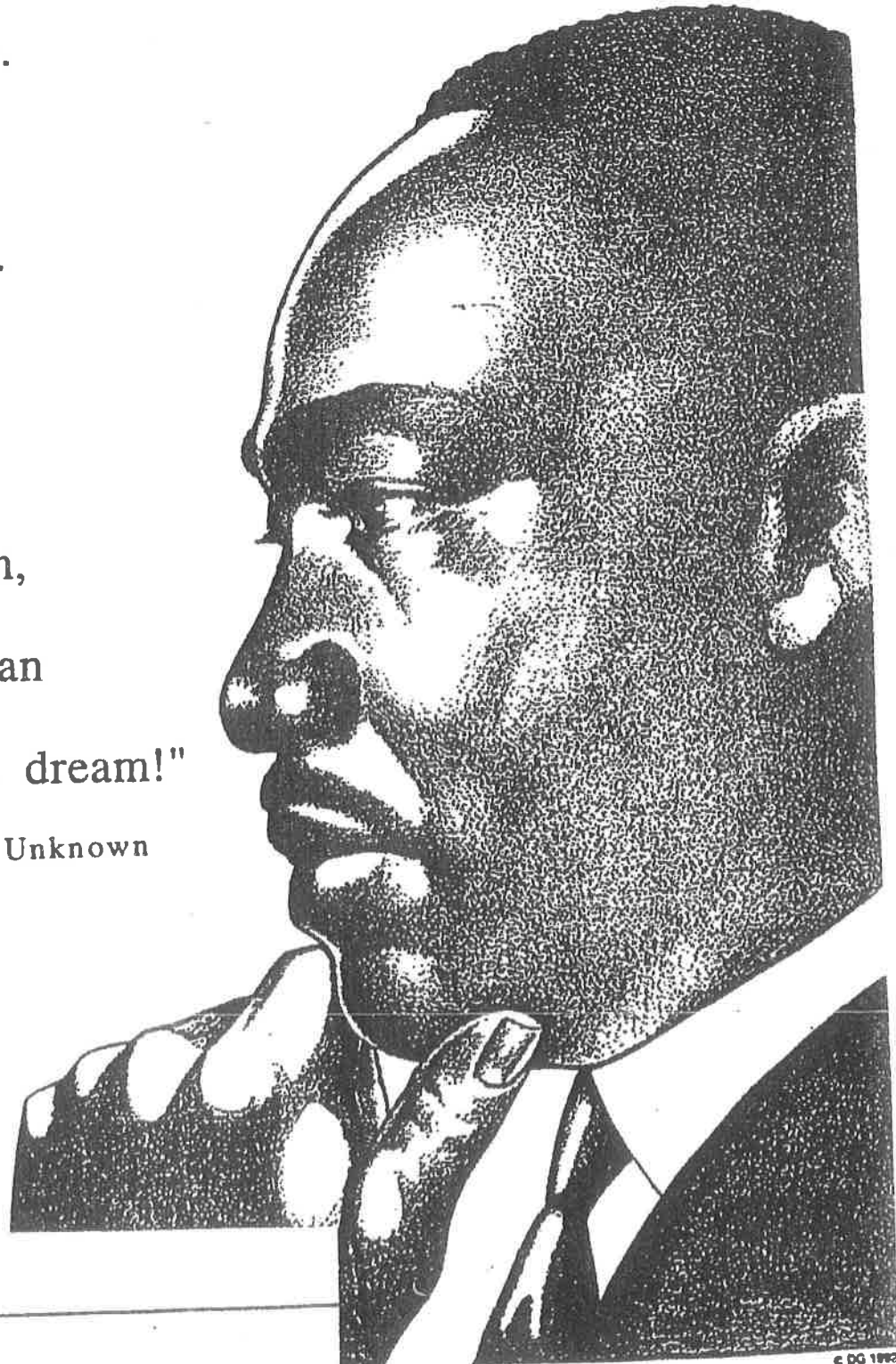
